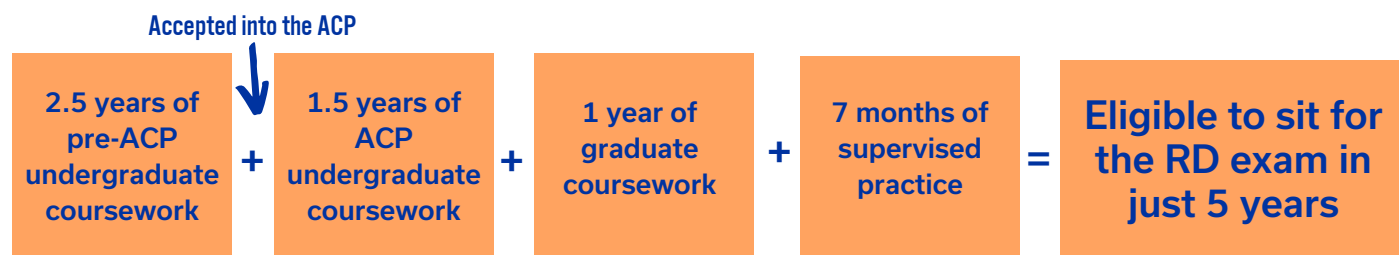


# Accelerated Coordinated Program (ACP)
