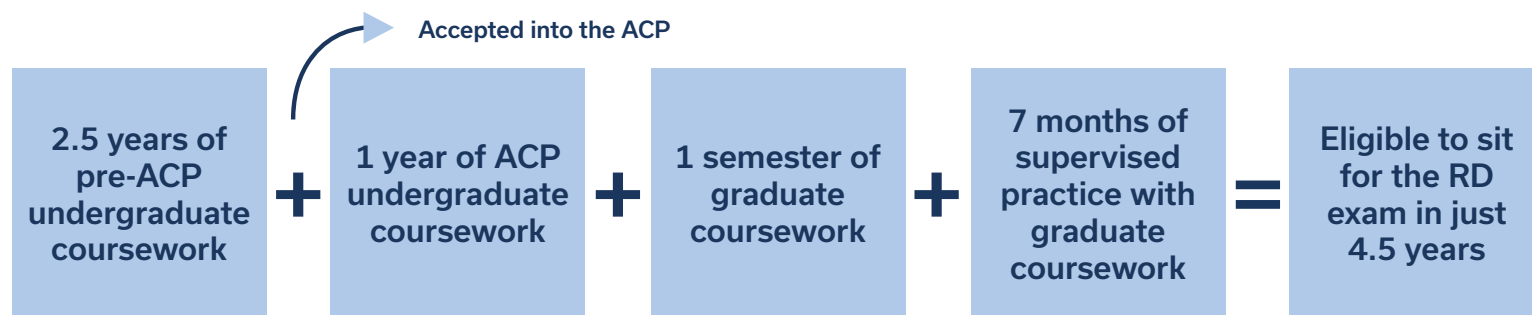


# ACCELERATED COORDINATED PROGRAM (ACP) IN DIETETICS
